Roslyn Theater Company is pleased to announce our Spring 2021 semester employing strict health protocols to safeguard the well being of your children and our staff.

Classes will be smaller — 10 to 12 students per class — and students will be socially distanced. Masks will be worn by the teachers and students, and temperatures will be taken upon entering the studio. There will be hand sanitizers and an air dryer in the bathroom.

The garage door at the entrance to the studio will be open to provide fresh air and good circulation.

COVID forms must be signed by parents when registering their child. Parents, babysitters, nannies, etc will not be permitted inside the studio. At the end of the class, students will leave one at a time upon advising either Jill or Juliana that a parent or designated adult is present for pick up.

Our final performances will depend on government guidelines. If we are not confident that an indoor stage show at the theater is advisable, we will use an outdoor venue.

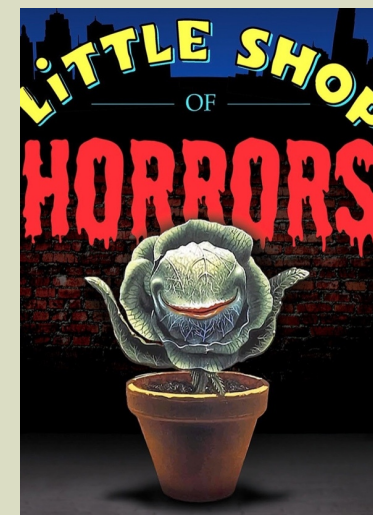
